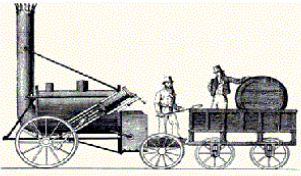

# HIGHBURN WHARF

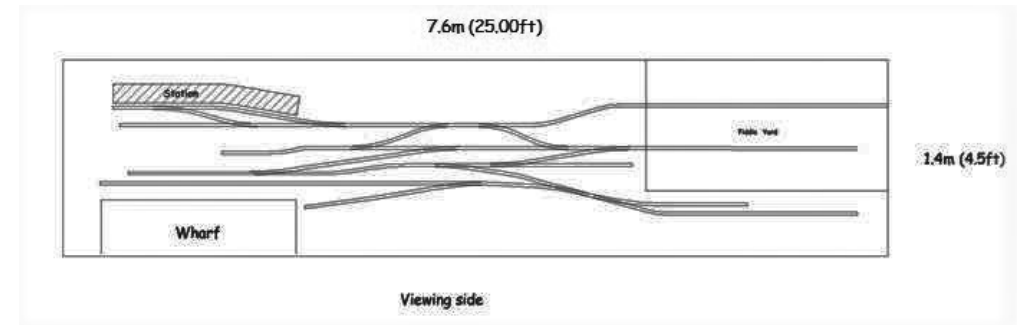
## 0-gauge Layout

The layout is set in the changeover period from steam to diesel (1950/1960's) and was built originally by the GWR somewhere on the Severn Estuary. Originally a small country terminus it now boasts a small goods yard, wharf and storage warehouse.

Large locomotives can use the branch and there is also a connection to the midland railway to enable goods from the wharf to get to the midlands as well as south to London.
